



Prague Survival Guide

ACCOMMODATION

A Plus Hostel, Na Florenci 33, www.aplus-hostel.cz, +420 222 314 272 Central location, close to Florenc bus and metro station and 1 metro stop from main train station Hlavni Nadrazi. Participants are booked into the dormitory and breakfast is included. Tell reception that you are coming for the World Carfree Network seminar.

SEMINAR VENUE

Dum techniky (Technical house), Novotneho Lavka 5, www.csvts.cz. Located near the Charles Bridge in the center of Prague. Tell reception you are coming for the World Carfree Network seminar and follow the signs inside to find the conference room. From the hostel to the seminar venue: Walk out of the hostel turn left to the main street and take bus 133 (tram stop) to Staromestska. Walk down the big street with trams to the left towards the Charles Bridge. Walk around the building on the corner next to the river.

FOOD

You will be provided with breakfast at the hostel and lunch at the seminar venue. The lunch will be vegetarian and vegan. Small refreshments will be available for the duration of the seminar. Participants have to cover their own dinner costs. Kitchen is available at the hostel.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Prague has an excellent integrated public transport system that combines metro, tram and bus. Metro operates from 5am to midnight, trams and buses all day and night. You can buy tickets from vending machines and ticket offices at metro and major tram stops, newsstands, kiosks, and tourist information offices. Tickets are valid for all the means of public transport. Validate your ticket (yellow stamp machines) before or as soon as you are on board to avoid a fine. WCN cannot reimburse your public transport tickets. Check timetables, connections and prices: www.dpp.cz

BICYCLE

Prague is not the best city for getting around by bike. Traffic is heavy, exhaust fumes can be choking, tram tracks can be dangerous and there are few dedicated cycle lanes. That said, the city now has about 180km of signposted cycle routes and the popularity of cycling is steadily increasing. Maps and more information at: www.doprava.prahamesto.cz. CHANGING MONEY

Czech currency is Czech koruna (CZK). There are many cash machines available in the city and in the metro, if you have a bank card. You can pay by card in majority of the bigger shops. You can change currency or travellers cheques in the main Czech banks,

or in a private exchange booth, but usually for a bad rate. Always ask how much you get before you change the money. Check exchange rates: www.xe.com
