

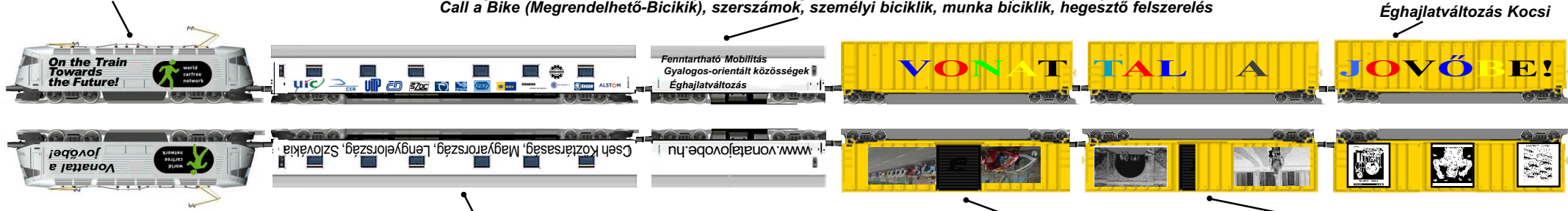

Promotion of railways is a major emphasis of **On the Train!** We hope to show how the latest and greatest efforts of the railways industry – such as clean, quiet, flexible and reliable locomotives & comfortable and accessible coaches.... in combination with all sorts of bicycle-based programs and infrastructure – can help national, regional and local governments implement sustainable development policies.

In **On the Train!**, *real, functional examples* of trains will be shown to citizens, government and industry of Central & Eastern Europe. By seeing what is possible, these groups will be encouraged to work together to discuss, study and purchase rail-based systems that match their needs and capabilities.

People's cars are new, so our trains have to be too! The individual theme presentations and events in **On the Train!** should be based in new individual freight cars, which will ideally be pulled by a modern multi-system or diesel locomotive. Staff will live in a new sleeper car. All of these vehicles will be open to the public, just like at an exhibition.

We envision that **On the Train!** will have something for almost everyone: Interactive multi-media installations, environmentally-themed puppet shows for children, construction of custom art-bicycles and free rides on modern rental bicycles, music, presentations by innovative transport engineers, urban planners and architects...and a film festival about trains. Events will take place on the train, in train stations and in areas nearby. More than just a spectacle, we also hope to help implement permanent changes in the communities we visit.

On the Train! is conceived as a unique and exciting way to showcase the modern functionality & environmental benefits of trains. **On the Train!** could be one of the best ways to help the governments and people of the Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland and Slovakia make the right decisions about the transport infrastructure they will invest in.... *and* their individual mobility choices.
